



**Old Fire Farts of York County  
Board Meeting  
February 2, 2025  
Eagle Fire Company, 54 Center Street, Mount Wolf, PA**

President Neil Gunnet called the meeting to order at 2:01 p.m. with the following in attendance: Neil Gunnet, Dick Staub, Greg Halpin, Harold Reinhold, and Jeff Stauffer.

Gunnet discussed the two outstanding bills from the 2024 SPAAMFAA Convention, T-Mugs and T&J Giftland Trophies. After a brief discussion, it was decided that these bills should be paid ASAP. Gunnet will contact Treasurer Webb and instruct him to pay these bills.

Gunnet reported that we received an invitation to again participate in York's St. Patrick's Day parade on Saturday, March 15<sup>th</sup>. It was agreed to participate, and Gunnet will contact Roy Gentzler to coordinate apparatus for the parade.

Gunnet reported that the Allentown Spring Melt is on Sunday, April 6<sup>th</sup> at the Allentown Fairgrounds. We have staffed a booth at this event in the past. It was decided to rent a space for \$80.00.

Gunnet reported that we received an invitation to the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary luncheon for the Union Historical Fire Society on March 22<sup>nd</sup> at 11:00 a.m. Jeff Stauffer is attending, and he will also represent our organization.

**Muster** – Gunnet reported that he attended a meeting of the local 4H club. Their organization will discuss the matter. They feel their facility should be big enough for our muster but may not be big enough if combined with the county convention. There was also concern with parking if there is a rain event. It may be possible to use the parking lot across the street at the armory. Gunnet will be attending the county association meeting. September 27, 2025 was selected as a tentative date for the muster.

It was decided to tentatively select the dates for the quarterly meetings in 2025. The following dates were selected: March 23<sup>rd</sup>, June 8<sup>th</sup>, August 24<sup>th</sup>, and November 2<sup>nd</sup>.

All meetings to be held at Hoss's East York. Secretary Halpin will contact Patti Webb to reserve the room at Hoss's and coordinate the Community Night fundraising with them.

A general discussion was held regarding fundraising ideas for the organization. There was discussion of holding feeds and other events and selling RADA knives and kitchen items. Vice President Staub will get more information on the RADA items. We will continue to work on other fundraising ideas.

Halpin asked about the folding tank that was left at the high school after the muster. A member failed to return it after the muster, and again failed to get it after being notified by the school district that it was still there. It is currently stored at the fire school, and it is OK to remain there.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:50 p.m.
